

The school receives additional funding for each pupil on roll registered as eligible for free school meals (FSM) during the last six years. Pupils' Premium was introduced in 2011-12 for disadvantaged pupils. Pupils eligible for this grant falls under three main categories:

- Pupils Looked after by the local authority and Ever 6 FMS children
- Pupils who are in care
- Families where a parent serves in the armed force

Benthal publishes an annual report on our website informing parents on how pupil premium has been used within the school. The PPG grant per pupil is approximately £1300 per pupil.

### Principles for using pupil premium

- We ensure that teaching and learning opportunities meet the needs of our pupils
- We ensure that appropriate provision is made for pupils who belong to vulnerable groups
- In making provision for socially disadvantaged pupils, we recognise that not all pupils who receive free school meals will be socially disadvantaged
- We also recognise that not all pupils who are socially disadvantaged are registered or qualify for free school meals therefore we reserve the right to allocate the Pupil Premium funding to support any pupil or groups of pupils the school has identified as being socially disadvantaged.
- Pupil premium funding will be allocated following a needs analysis which will identify priority classes, groups or individuals.
- Limited funding and resources means that not all children receiving free school meals will be in receipt of pupil premium interventions at one time
- Our pupil premium funding is aimed at accelerating progress and ensuring pupils reach at least national age expected.
- Pupil premium resources may also be used to target our more able pupils on FSM
- Pupil premium will also be used in providing enrichment programmes for our disadvantaged pupils

## **PROVISION**

The provision that we are providing includes:

- Providing small group work in literacy and numeracy with experienced teachers focusing on overcoming gaps in learning
- One to one tutorials for individual pupils
- Additional Mentor support for pupils with emotional media
- Additional after school activities
- Workshops for pupils
- Pupil enrichment programmes

The Pupil Premium Grant allocation for 2014/15 is targeted at raising the attainment of pupils in speaking, reading and writing in Early Years Foundation Stage and literacy and numeracy at Key Stage.
