

Numeracy

This term in Numeracy we will be covering:

Numbers to 10

The children will be consolidating and ordering 1 and 2 digit numbers and comparing more or less in sets.

Ordinal numbers

Using common every day words, children will know ordinal numbers and their position.

Addition within 10

Building on prior knowledge children will find different ways to add and understand addition stories and word problems.

Subtraction within 10

The children will find different ways to subtract and understand subtraction stories and word problems.

Length

Children will measure, order and compare 2 or more lengths.

2D shapes

Children will learn shape names and identify



Literacy

Our author focus this term will be Jill Murphy.

Fiction: Stories with familiar settings

We will be focusing on a range of traditional stories. Children will identify the main characters and describe them using adjectives. They will re-tell the story using simple sentences.

Poetry: Repetitive Poems

The children will read a range of poems with repetitive phrases. Then, they will explore the rhythm and patterns within each poem.

Homework

We will be focusing on developing the children's reading and children need to bring their reading books **every day** so that we can read with them as often as possible. Please ensure that you read with your child daily and feedback to us about how they are doing using the Home Reading Record. SEAL & PHSE

Circle time is a time for children to gather together and share their personal feelings and ideas about anything that is significant to them.

The focus this term in our SEAL topic is **New Beginnings** and we will discuss themes around this on a weekly basis during circle time, e.g. how to deal with changes.

You can help by discussing these themes at home.

R.E

This term we will be learning about Festivals, including Harvest Festival, Diwali and Christmas. The children will explore how and why people celebrate festivals. They will think about what they are thankful for in their own lives as well as the importance of sharing with others.

ICT

Firstly, the children will be learning how to log on and off a computer as well as locating some keys on a keyboard.

Then, they will be learning about the importance of the technology around us and how it helps us daily.

Science

To coincide with the BCC topic, the children will learn about seasonal changes as we head into autumn and winter. Children will think about how the weather is different across the seasons and will record and observe some of the changes that they see. They will also learn about the importance of the sun and its role in helping plants to grow.

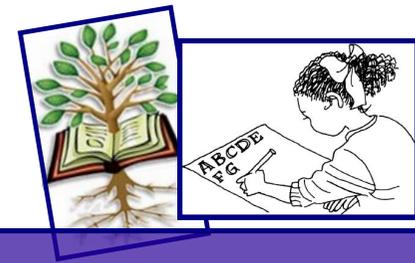
Phonics

In KS1, we will be teaching phonics in groups. We will consolidate the sounds that the children already know and begin to introduce new sounds.

Physical Education

We will have two P.E. sessions a week, on **Wednesdays** and **Thursdays**. The focus will be on basic movement, balance, coordination and ability. PE kit must include:

The children will learn the names and locations of all the different continents. Each week they will focus on one celebration from each continent. They will consider the history and reasons for each celebration. The children will make lots of crafts linked to these celebrations. Some examples include:
