

Numeracy

Number:

We will be exploring place value, comparing and ordering numbers.

We will use practical and pictorial methods such as grouping, making numbers using tens and ones to help children understand the concept behind addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

Furthermore, we will practise all number pairs that makes each number up to 10 and 20. We will also look at the tens pairs that add up to 100.

Lastly, we will apply our learning to everyday situations by solving problems.

Homework:

- Recall addition and subtraction up to 20.
- Learning their 2,5 and 10 times tables.
- On a fortnightly basis, we will be sending home written maths work



Literacy

Guided Reading:

Every day children will be set a reading task. Once a week your child will read with the class teacher and/ or Teacher Assistant as part of their Guided Reading.

Children will bring their reading books at least once a week to be changed. Please ensure that you listen to your child read each week and record this in their reading record.

Our author focus is *Lauren Child*. We will be reading, analysing and researching books from this author.

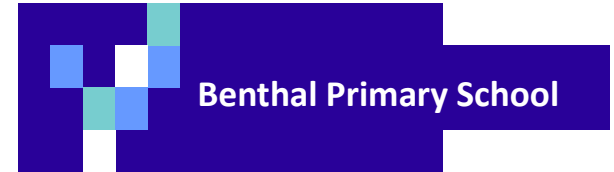
Writing Focus:

Our writing stimuli will come from books to enrich children's vocabulary and to provide stimuli. We will be using Talk for Writing to help every child compose grammatically correct sentences in different genres.

SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar): The focus this term will be on word types such as nouns, verbs and adjectives as well as tenses and exception words.

Homework:

Children will receive spellings to practice once a week, plus a fortnightly written task.

This term we will be studying the following topics:

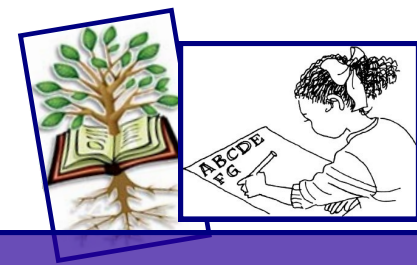
Everyday materials: We will group materials and, in a series of small tests, investigate their properties to find out their uses.
