Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: School clubs

Benthal afterschool clubs will resume from week beginning 16th January 2017. Please see a list of the clubs on the reverse of this letter; please note that even if your child attended a club last term, you are required to reapply.

If you are interested in your child joining any of the clubs, please fill out the slip below and return it to school office by Wednesday 11th January, 5pm. If we have too many children interested in joining a specific club, we will use a "first come, first served" system and start a reserve list for those who have not been allocated a place. We will let you know on Friday 13th January which club your child has been successful for, and we will try to ensure that each child has a place in at least one club.

All clubs are chargeable; before your child starts all fees must be paid in full for the term. We will be running afterschool clubs for 10 weeks in the spring term, clubs will finish on week beginning 26th March.

The cost for the term is **£20 per club**, payable in advance to the school office. **Please note no forms will be accepted without full payment attached.** Clubs are free for all children, attending playcentre on the same day.

For sport and dance clubs the children will need their PE kit:

- White T-shirt
- Black shorts/jogging bottoms
- Pumps/trainers

Children must be picked up at the end of each club promptly, continuous late pick up could result in their place being withdrawn.

Please note: The clubs may be subject to cancellation due to staff illness etc. We will let you know as early as possible by text. Please provide emergency contact details below should a club have to be cancelled, if different from the one we have on our system.
